Ferndale Historical Society Notes:

Vita-Wheat Baked Products was a wholesale bakery opened in 1951 at 1839 Hilton (near the corner of East Nine Mile) by J. E. Berry. There was a gas station actually on the corner (751 E. Nine) until at least the late 1950s. In 1965 Vita-Wheat expanded their facility at the corner. The business was dissolved on Dec 31, 1986. Contents were auctioned off on Feb 26, 1987. We have not found a record of when the building was remodeled into the current structure.
